We realize that \$3500 may cover total expenses for some projects and only part for others. If your project will cost more than \$3,500, please mention how you will supplement the fellowship. Feel free to indicate in your proposal why you believe that your financial circumstances justify support from the Class of '38 fellowship.

PROPOSAL FORMAT

Please read the above guidelines carefully in preparing your proposal. All application materials must be submitted on 8 ½" x 11" white paper. Use 10 point or larger type on your proposal. The length can vary from 2 pages (approximately 500 words) to 4 pages. The Selection Committee is not concerned with the length of the proposal, but rather your ability to communicate the nature of your project, the importance of the project to you personally and/or professionally, the overall feasibility of the project, and financial circumstances impacting your ability to realize this project without Class of '38 funding.

SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIALS

In addition to the proposal, you are invited (but not required) to attach maps, itineraries, or special information you've acquired which relate to your study abroad project. If your proposed experience requires obtaining special permission from companies, archives, government agencies, faculty members, or other individuals/organizations, letters of support or authorization may be attached.

An official transcript is required as part of the application.
